

## WOMENS RUGBY WORLD CUP

### TICKET TERMS & CONDITIONS

#### Conditions of Sale

Tickets will be issued at the discretion of the International Rugby Board (IRB) in co-operation with Rugby Football Union Women and its authorised agent for the Women's Rugby World Cup 2010 ("the Event") on the following Conditions:-

1. Tickets are issued subject to the Conditions of Sale. The ticket seller is IRB c/o RFUW.
2. Tickets shall only be purchased or obtained through RFUW c/o Ticketmaster UK Ltd and Harlequins RFC Box Office.
3. The use of tickets as prizes in lotteries or competitions without the prior written consent of the IRB and RFUW is expressly prohibited.
4. **Tickets shall not be resold, donated or transferred** (save as mentioned in 6 below) to any person or entity whether for the purpose of commercial gain or otherwise. The unauthorised sale or transfer of a ticket or any attempt to resell a ticket will result in the ticket being rendered invalid. Any attempt to resell a ticket includes advertising a ticket for sale, whether on the internet or otherwise.
5. **Any ticket obtained in breach of these conditions shall be void and all rights connected therewith shall be nullified. Any person seeking to use a ticket obtained in breach of these conditions will be a trespasser, and will be refused entry or ejected from the venue and demarcated areas. In such circumstances no refund will be payable and such a person will be liable to legal action.**
6. If more than one ticket is purchased those tickets may only be used by the purchaser and the person[s] accompanying the purchaser. The provision of such ticket[s] by the purchaser to such person[s] shall not invalidate the ticket[s].
7. Possession of a ticket does not confer any rights (by implication or otherwise) on the purchaser to use, alter, copy or otherwise deal with any of the symbols, trade marks, logos and/or intellectual property appearing on the ticket.
8. If a purchaser attempts to purchase more than the maximum number of tickets, the IRB and RFUW reserves the right to cancel all of the purchases in full.

9. IRB and RFUW reserves the right to change the schedule of play without notice where it is in its opinion reasonably necessary to do so.
10. The tickets at all times remain the property of RFUW.
11. Admittance for young children varies across both venues in use for the competition, for guidance please visit the FAQ section at [RFU.com/TheGame/Competitions/WomensRugbyWorldCup.aspx](http://RFU.com/TheGame/Competitions/WomensRugbyWorldCup.aspx)
12. Other than as stated in clause 13 below the IRB and RFUW, its staff, agents or servants shall not be liable for any loss, damage or expense caused by cancellation, curtailment or change of schedule of the Event because of government action, strike, civil commotion, national disaster or other force majeure or cause beyond the reasonable control of RFUW .
13. RFUW shall only refund the purchase price of the ticket (and shall have no liability for any further sums) where play is cancelled or postponed without any play and the reason for cancellation or postponement is an event against which RFUW is insured. Other than in these circumstances, tickets cannot be exchanged or refunded after purchase. In no case shall any liability (other than for death or personal injury) of RFUW, its staff, agents or contractors arising from acts or defaults at or near the venue or otherwise in respect of the Event include any liability for indirect or consequential loss or damage.
14. RFUW will accept no responsibility if the original ticket is stolen or mislaid and tickets can only be replaced on provision of satisfactory purchase evidence. Lost or stolen tickets cannot be refunded.
15. If any provision of these terms is declared by any judicial or other competent authority to be void voidable illegal or otherwise unenforceable the provision shall be amended in such a reasonable manner or it may be severed from the terms and in either event the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.
16. RFUW reserves the right to refuse ticket holders admission to the venue in reasonable circumstances including for health and safety, licensing reasons or where a ticket is void. RFUW also reserves the right to request that ticket holders leave the venue at any point on reasonable grounds and may take any appropriate action to enforce this right. By way of example, ticket holders may be removed who have behaved in the venue in a manner which, in the reasonable opinion of the RFUW has, or is likely to affect the enjoyment of other visitors; or uses

threatening, abusive or insulting words or behaviour or in any way provokes or behaves in a manner which may provoke a breach of the peace; or in the reasonable opinion of RFUW is acting under the influence of alcohol or drugs; or fails, when required, to produce proof of identity or age. A Ticket Holder must comply with instructions and directions given by venue staff and stewards. No refunds will be given to ticket holders who are refused entry or ejected due to their own behaviour as suggested in, but not limited to, the examples above.

17. By attending the Event, ticket holders consent to filming and sound recording of themselves as members of the audience. IRB and RFUW and its licensees and those authorised by it may use such films and recordings (including any copies) without payment.
18. These Conditions are subject to English Law.
