## HONORARY LIFE MEMBERSHIP OF THE RFUW

## **Purpose of Honorary Life Membership**

To recognise individuals who have contributed in a major way to the administration or development of the Rugby Football Union for Women (RFUW).

On receiving an Honorary Life Membership the individual will be a member of the RFUW until their death, or the disbandment of the RFUW. They will be bound by the Memorandums and Articles of the RFUW.

## **Eligibility**

Individuals will be eliqible for Honorary Life Membership in one or more of the following ways:

- 1. An individual who has previously held the post of the RFUW Chairman of the Board of Directors.
- 2. Any individual who has held an RFUW Board position for five or more seasons.
- 3. Any other individual as nominated by the Board of Directors of the RFUW.

On an annual basis the Honorary Life Member will receive:

- 1. A copy of the RFU/W Handbook.
- 2. A free invitation to all RFUW International fixtures held within the countries under the jurisdiction of the RFUW.
- 3. An invitation to the Annual General Meeting the Honorary Life Member will not be entitled to vote at that meeting unless qualified to do so under the terms of the Memorandum and Articles of association.
- 4. A free copy of any regular newsletter issued by the RFUW.
- 5. Any other benefit as determined appropriate by the Board of Directors of the RFUW.

The RFUW reserves the right to withdraw Honorary Life Membership if an individual brings the organisation or women's rugby into disrepute.
